Subject: Explanation for Exception from Provincial or Territorial Attestation Letter (PAL or TAL) Requirement

Respected Immigration Officer,

I am writing to provide clarification regarding my study permit extension and why I am exempt from submitting a Provincial Attestation Letter (PAL).

According to the guidelines from Immigration, Refugees and Citizenship Canada (IRCC), a PAL is not required when:

- An individual is applying for a study permit extension at the same Designated Learning Institution (DLI) and at the same level of study as their current study permit.
