- 1) Introduce yourself and what studies have you been accepted to.
- 2) Why do you wish to study in Canada in the program for which you have been accepted?
- 3) What is your overall educational/career goal and how will your education in Canada enhance your future goal?
- 4) How will this program enhance your employment opportunities in your country of residence/citizenship?
- 5) Why are you not pursuing a similar program in your country of residence/citizenship?
- 6) What research have you done into studies in your country of residence or of citizenship?
- 7) What ties do you have to your country of residence/citizenship? (Example: Responsibilities to family, work, children, etc.)
- 8) Please provide a detailed explanation to the financial source that you will use to support your study in Canada such as who will pay the expenses in Canada, how much is available in total and where does the money come from, what is the main income of the person paying the expenses, what other assets does the person have and their market value, the daily expenses of the person paying the expenses
